







## Google Trends interest for the search term "Chemtrails" over the past two years





#### **Chemtrails**


- Conspiracy theory
- Created by "them"
- Do not exist
- Popular Google search
- Secret, dark, exciting
- No proof
- But easy to communicate

#### **Contrails**

- Science
- Created by physics
- Exist and have a climate impact
- 85% less searched for
- Needs to be explained
- Plenty of proof
- But harder to communicate

### What do people know?






- 2/3 are not really familiar with contrails
- But when given more information about contrails and their climate impact, 2/3 are now positive towards airlines adopting contrails mitigation

### What do people know?


- UC Berkeley consultancy, 180 DC, conducted a survey, commissioned by Contrails.org
- 317 respondents, mainly younger, mainly from the US West Coast, mainly in higher education
- Only 1 of 3 (37%) knew what contrails are
- 97% of respondents reported having seen a contrails

When guessing why contrails form, 83% guessed correctly

 Similar levels of concern from people who knew about contrails beforehand and people who did not know.



### contrails



- What do you see?
  - White lines in the sky
  - Human made or artificial clouds
- Are they bad?
  - At least as bad as CO2
- How do they form?
  - Atmospheric conditions
  - Particles + water = crystals.
  - Cooling vs warming effect
- What can we do and when?
  - Targeted problem
  - Adjust flight path
  - CO2 penalty vs climate benefits
- How much does it cost?
  - Cheap





### **Lesson 3: Reframing uncertainty**

#### **Outcome: Operation Blue Skies**

The timeline to deploy contrail avoidance is highly uncertain. To ensure global operation by 2050, Airspace–Scale Living Labs must be completed by 2030.





- The climate impact of contrails carries a high degree of uncertainty (± 70%).
- Despite these uncertainties, there
  is a scientific consensus that
  contrail warming has a significant
  net-warming climate impact.
- Reframe to: "It is certain that contrails are warming, the question is by how much".
- Action is therefore beneficial: worst case, we burn 1% more fuel. Best case, we reduce global warming by 2%.





March 2025: Of the thousands of airlines worldwide, THIRTYFIVE airlines have made it into the index.

The Airline Contrail Index is divided into four tiers - Platinum, Gold, Silver, and Bronze - reflecting the airlines' level of engagement in contrail management. Please note that the index reflects what has been publicly communicated and does not include airline contrail activities that are not (yet) public. Also, note that the overall climate goal is to get aviation to net zero as fast as possible, and while contrail management is a cheap and easy way to get rid of a lot of warming, it must never be at the expense of decarbonization. Aviation's CO2 emissions and non-CO2 emissions (including contrails) must always be addressed in parallel.
